The Interreg MED Programme is the transnational European Cooperation Programme for the Mediterranean area. Partners from 13 countries including the whole Northern Mediterranean seacoast are working together.

The transnational setup allows them to tackle challenges beyond national borders, such as the rise of low carbon economy, protection of natural and cultural resources and strengthening innovation.

Enhancing Mediterranean Governance

Obj. 4,1 - To enhance the development of a sustainable and responsible coastal and maritime tourism in the MED area.

Partnership:

Cofinancing only for public ERDF partners.

Types of actions :

Thematic concentration, consultation processes and studies, networks of public authorities to improve decision making processes and foster common views and strategies.

Key target groups:

Projects financed should involve various regional, national and international bodies





What's new?

- > Diversifying the range of MED actors: Private sector (SMEs) / Civil society
- > Projects organised by modules of 12/18 months
 - > Module 1: Studying
 - > Module 2: Testing
 - > Module 3: Capitalization

> Focus on thematic communities, implemented by horizontal projects

What budget?

- > Around 275 M€
- > 224 M€ ERDF + 9,3M€ IPA + co-financing
- > ERDF co-financing rate for partners not concerned by state aid: 85%

> ERDF co-financing rate for economic operators and structures concerned by state aid: 85% or 50%
